Introduction

The Bible Spell-a-thon was initiated out of a need to increase interest as well as bring the children back to a love for the most valuable book- the BIBLE. Many children are incentive driven, hence the idea of character building books, trophies, Bibles and other gifts to heighten involvement and interest. The idea was piloted at the Constant Spring SDA Church in 2011. Providence had it that one of the recipients - Loshane Comrie was one of the category champions.

This is a healthy Sabbath activity after lunch. **The objective is to have the children immersed in the pages of the Bible.**

The Bible Spell-a-thon begins in January with parents reading or engaging their children in selected chapters of the Bible as well as words to study and ends in December with an awards exercise. It is a good after lunch activity to engage our children as they have fun immersing in the pages of the Bible.

This exercise is open to all children, **14 years** and below. It begins in January with children reading selected chapters of the Bible as well as words to study. It ends in December with an awards exercise.

The participants should:

1. Learn to spell the books of the Bible
2. Learn the books that fall under various categories, e.g. major & minor prophets, gospels
3. Read, Memorize and share selected portions from the Bible
4. State at least two (2) things about each word they spell
5. Engage in games using parts of speech in the Bible.
6. Continue in the 'WORD' with related Bible activities throughout the year.
7. Sing/say the books of the Bible
8. Share stories from selected portions of the Bible
9. **Invite non SDA children/your regular visitors to participate. (Will be recognized in a separate category)**

EJC Final Junior Words (10-12 years) contd.

10. Continue in the 'WORD' with related Bible activities throughout the year

Read, memorize and share selected portions from the Bible.

State at least 3 things about each word they spell

Engage in games using parts of speech in the Bible.

Continue in the 'WORD' with related Bible activities throughout the year.

Categories

The exercise is divided into 4 levels and five categories:-

Cradle Roll—Under 4 years Kindergarten—4—6 years

Primary—Over 6 and under 10 years Junior 10 - 12 years

Earli-teen over 12 and under 14 years

Church

Engage all children. Enter one boy and one girl from each category for the EJC level. This will allow for one male and one female champion per category.

Orientation/Initiation

At the beginning of any Bible Spell-a-thon activity all participants should be engaged in the memorization of the books of the Bible and the singing of the song, "Now let us Children try to tell the books of the Bible we love so well."

Rules

1. Spellers have a maximum of one (1) minute to spell a word after it has been given. The judge may move to another participant if a speller ignores a request to start spelling.

2. The spellers may ask the Spell Master to repeat the word. The Spell Master must grant this request. Judges must ensure that the word has been pronounced clearly to the speller. The Spell Master and judges will not entertain root word questions.
3. After being given a word, the speller is encouraged to repeat it. If the speller mispronounces a word, it is up to the judges to make sure the Spell Master correctly pronounced the word.
4. A speller who has started spelling a word may stop and start over after repeating the word but cannot change the previous spelling. Any change made to the previous spelling will be considered an error.
5. A speller is allowed TWO HANDICAPS and is out of the competition when he/she spells the SECOND word incorrectly.
6. When there are two finalists left, and a word is spelt incorrectly, the Spell Master must not correct it. The other speller must also not be asked to spell the word. He/she will spell the next word on the list. If this is done correctly, then he/she will be declared the champion. If this is incorrect, the speller has one handicap and so must be allowed to spell another word. The judges' decision is final.

Bible Spell-a-thon eliminations should be done under the supervision of the Children’s Ministries Sponsor /Director/Team.

Each church is to send the names of the male and female champion in each category to the EJC Office.

CHURCH LEVEL:

1. Invite all children to participate in learning the books of the Bible .
2. Immerse children in KIDS Praise
