Dr. Jenifer Daley

Associate Professor, Northern Caribbean University

Jenifer A. Daley is an inter-disciplinary theologian with degrees in systematic theology (Ph.D., SDA Theological Seminary, Andrews University, 2019) and economics (Ph.D., Cardiff University, 2002). She is a Fellow of the Association of Certified Chartered Accountants UK (FCCA) and the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Jamaica (FCA).

Before responding to God's call to full-time gospel ministry, Jenifer worked in business (including as Senior Economist, Bank of Jamaica; Manager, Finance & Operations, Scotiabank Jamaica; Consultant, PricewaterhouseCoopers) and as a professor of business (including Senior Lecturer at The University of the West Indies, and Visiting Professor at The University of Akron and Cardiff University). While studying theology, she also taught business courses at Newbold College (England) and Andrews University (USA) and has also taught at the SDA Theological Seminary at Andrews University.
